

The board further directs the president to work with academic review teams tidiperiand determine which areas may require additional time past the November 20719 meeting and to provide those new target dates to the board in November along with recommended changes or findings, these reviews shall include typical information or continuous program reviews to the extent available his motion is effective September 12, 2019.

- 3. Assuming a peer average **full**he **s**udent:faculty ratio, what would be the instructional cost reduction compared to our current state?
- 4. What issues need to be resolved if the unit is assigned to one of our three separately accredited universities?
- 5. What issues need to be resolve defunit is part of a single accredited statewide university?

In preparing your reportonsider the impacts of the transfer funding eductions and enrollment declines that UA is currently facing, also any issues specialized accreditation where appropriate) that could arise by a change in overall university structure or accreditation.
